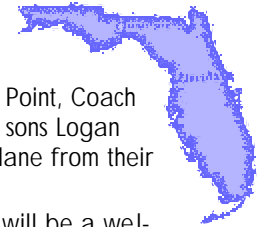

# Spring Break Training



Where in the world is Alligator Point, Florida??? The 2003 Cycledelics—along with Charlie Metzger, Cameron Stouder and the seven riders from this year's Dodds team—are going to find out firsthand this Spring Break when they travel there for a week of intense training.

The team plans to leave Bloomington by car the evening of March 14, 2003. When they arrive late the next day, they will discover that Alligator Point is a small island in the Gulf of Mexico off the coast of Tallahassee, FL. The island, which is approximately eight miles long and less than one mile wide, is home to *Kate's Dream*, the house that the teams are renting, as well as several other rental houses, a boatyard, and a large, well-packed dirt lot (perfect for practicing exchanges!).

By the time the riders reach Alligator Point, Coach Glenn Spiczak, his wife Heather, and sons Logan and Blake, will have arrived via airplane from their home in Wisconsin to meet them.

Florida's warm weather and sunshine will be a welcome respite from the record-breaking snow levels and cold temperatures this winter has brought to southern Indiana. The riders will do various workouts each day, including time trials, sprints, pack riding, bike handling skills, and of course, exchanges. They also will have the opportunity to get to know one another better and have some time to relax. All of these things will help prepare the riders mentally and physically for Qualifications on March 29, 2003, and ultimately the race itself, which is scheduled for April 25, 2003.
