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Coming Out Of Your Personal “HELL” called Desire!

Some people are their own worst enemy. What I mean is that they follow their own wrong desires and enter their own personal hell of bondage on this earth. They are burning with wrong desires... lust inside them... and they cannot resist it in themselves. They tremble with these desires that they be fulfilled. They are completely consumed in their minds with those thoughts and the notions to do them. They are at odds with themselves in this personal hell because they will never ever be satisfied, not in this world nor in the place where they will be staying for eternity. **Prov. 4:16 For they sleep not, except they have done mischief (their unfulfilled lusts and desires haunt them day and night)**

Desires Of The Flesh And Mind

Eph. 2:3 Among whom also we all had our conversation (behavior) in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

“Desire of the flesh and of the mind” – those self gratifying desires which take us away from the Lord, from His Spirit, His Word and His Ways.

We are told in Scripture that wrong desires from God’s perspective will take us to Hell! In the verse above, may we point out that lust is wrong desires against the Lord. It takes and separates us from a relationship with God erecting a barrier of sin between us and Him. For the impenitent, it causes them to be sent into damnation (eternal punishment) by the judgment of God. Notice here why so many will be lost into hell:

Jn. 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

The Lust Factor Will Send You

Lust is the factor that will cause them to miss heaven altogether. Lust is a lie... Lust is an untruth that people believe and carry out despite the consequences of their own eternal destruction. Let’s look further...

1Jn. 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

Our eyes and ears are the gate or entrance of images and thoughts which can be contrary to the Lord and according to the thinking of this fallen world... the false which presents itself as the truth (but not according to God's perspective).

James 1:15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

These thoughts, words, and images enter into people's heart and cause them to try to live out the LIE... the desires that are contrary to God's Word and Ways.

James 1:14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.

It is this drawing away that is dangerous. Once the lust enters and passes through the eyes and ears and through the mind into the heart it can lodge there and setup its destruction in our lives. This is why Jesus speaks of cutting off wrong desires using this example:

Matt. 5:30 And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Mk. 9:43 And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

Mk. 9:45 And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

Cutting off wrong motivations and desires is a matter of taking in the mind of Christ by mind renewal to see the truth (God's perspective) which will deliver us and cause strongholds (the wrong desires) to be broken through a reorientation with right discernment and His divine order. This receiving of His truth will cause us to see clearly in mind and spirit again and enable us to stop the former behavior (acting out sinfully) against the Lord's divine will for our lives.

1Pet. 4:2 That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, ((but to the will of God)).

The problem with the sinner is that they are; through bondage suffering in their own type of personal HELL! They have been allured and entered into that bondage by those who have represented to them and sold them a LIE. They were told that it is liberty to partake of your forbidden desires... you can cross over any line in fulfilling your lusts and desires. They have pleasure in watching those commit the same sins as they. The devil and his crew always enjoy another person in the boat because they are together servants of their own sins and live for this corruption.

Rom. 1:32 Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

2Pet. 2:19 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

Jn. 8:34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is (the servant of sin)).

The progression of these burning lusts for that which is against the Lord is that the Lord gives them up... to these desires!!!

Rom. 1:27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.

Here the passage is speaking of the burning desires of lust receiving a lie as the truth and trying to live out those lies against the divine and against natural laws which the Lord set in place for mankind's preservation. We are told here that lust and wrong desires are ERROR and never the truth of God, never that which the Lord supports. The consequences for this denial is receiving the punishment for their sin.

Rom. 1:28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

Very dangerous...

These were those that once had the insight of God's truth in their conscience with the knowledge and discernment of the divine truth, yet lust and wrong desires caused them to throw away the truth of God... God then did give them over – delivered them unto their evil corruptions for their own destructions because they wouldn't listen.

Gal. 5:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do (practise) such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Rom. 8:6 For to be carnally (following lustful desires of the mind) minded is death (spiritual death); but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

These lusts of the flesh and the mind cause people live a lifestyle according to their own lusts of which the Apostle Paul says the teaching is clear that they will not receive everlasting life in heaven.

Jn. 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already (in their sins), because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God (the only escape).

The condemnation and judgment of Hell and eternal damnation is something already in place for those who have not Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. You see, the judgment for the sinner has already been determined so that the appearance of the sinner in coming before God to be judged is already set in place.

Heb. 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment (receiving of the judgment):

The judgment is already set in place for mankind. When those who die “in Christ” “justified” and “cleansed” the angel of the Lord is present at death already knowing the person’s status and escorts them into heaven, else as a spirit without a body we wouldn’t know how to get to heaven. When a sinner dies, however, his spirit leaves his body and no angel of God is present there, but the demons to incarcerate him.

Matt. 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him (a proper respect toward the Lord’s holiness and justice) which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

We are to fear the Lord with a proper respect and for His Word which says that He is able to destroy both the soul and body in hell. After the body and soul are destroyed that only leaves the evil wicked lust and desires in their spirit of those who are now in hell.

The desire that the sinner lived for... the lust and wrong desires that they received and lived out in their actions that went against the Word of God and divine order are still present within them, yet now they have not a body any longer in which to live out these wrong desires... the lust that took them to Hell is still present eating them up inside and now they will face an eternity of having those desires eat away at them with no escape from their torment. Without the body in hell these desires are **THEIR WORM...**

Isaiah 66:24 And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcasses of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh.

Mk. 9:44 Where (((their worm))) dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.

Mk. 9:46 Where (((their worm))) dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.

Mk. 9:48 Where (((their worm))) dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.

Not a literal worm...

Their worm is... their lust... their wrong desires... what they lived for... what they wanted... now has taken up residence in their spirit and their sin will be their own torments for all eternity. Knowing this is enough for anyone to depart their sin.

DETERMINE NOW TO BE DELIVERED!

Gen. 19:15 And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.

To be delivered you must arise and depart the lust and wrong desires... for the Scriptures warns ... if you do not you will be consumed with this lust...

Gen. 19:17 And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.

Escape FOR YOUR ETERNAL LIFE!!!

“Look not behind you... Escape lest you be consumed...by the coming judgment!

Jn. 5:14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

Jesus was clear that once deliverance is present “sin not more”

The worse thing is the Worm!

Gen. 19:26 But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, (((giving themselves over))) to fornication, and (((going after))) strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

The Worm (her wrong desires) was still in Lot’s wife. Even though she had fled out of Sodom her heart was still occupied with the lust and wrong desires... she turned back in her heart and was judged in like manner with Sodom. These are examples of how the Lord once delivered and yet suffered vengeance of fire upon the disobedient. Notice above that they gave themselves over... going after... these were those who were stronger in their lust and serving themselves than strong in the Lord’s Spirit and living for Him.

Eph. 5:15 See then that ye walk circumspectly (the observation of Lordship – following the Lord’s will), not as fools, but as wise

Our Lord is to be given the primary place in our lives... and His Spirit’ Lordship must be heeded and promptings not ignored over our human spirit, soul, and body. This means we must expect His checks in our lives if we are truly and fully His.

Gal. 5:24,25 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

When a person has fully laid their own wrong desires and disobedience before the Lord and His Cross – confessing their lusts openly, then the power of the Spirit will crucify their personal intentions and fleshly leadings that are evil and begin taking control of their lives to *live pleasing* before Him.

Mk. 3:35 For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.

Christian are to live **NOT** out of *their own* will but **OUT OF** *God's will*... This is ...“The Way, The Truth, and The Life” of a true Christian!

Rom. 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit (the Lordship of the Spirit) of God, they are the sons of God (namely those ones who are the followers of Jesus in His Word and Spirit).

The origin of Sonship with God is dependant upon who's spirit you are following.

Guarding Against Sin And Leaving Besetting Sins

Rom. 6:1-4 ... Shall we sin to our heart's content and see how far we can exploit the grace of God? (exploitation of God's grace by continuation in following the *flesh-sinful lusts and evil intentions* – and never a separation of the sinning from the sinner and sinner from their personal sins) What a ghastly thought! (“*The Lie!*” - To think we don't and cannot change *these patterns in us* and *that we remain the same*... going on *sinning and saying*, “*God's grace has saved me*” when both words *salvation and deliverance* are progressive action verbs!) We, who have died to sin – how could we live in sin a moment longer? (Moments longer of living in the past actions of our former lives (so do we think that our sins are good and that consequence and destruction doesn't ensue?... speaking of motives and wrong desires to continue to do so...) Have you forgotten that all of us who were baptized into Jesus Christ were, by that very action, sharing in His death? We were dead and buried with Him in baptism, so that just as He was raised from the dead by that splendid revelation of the Father's power so we too might rise to life on a new plane altogether. (Phillips Trans.)

Our position “In Christ” as Christians is that we are *dead* toward sin and made *alive* toward God to live out *a new life* after the power of His resurrection.

Rom. 6:7 For he that is dead is freed from sin. What is Freed mean?

Heb. 12:1 ... let us lay aside (abandon) ...the sin (those lusts and wrong desires) which doth so easily beset us (bring us back into sin and bondage), and let us run with patience the race that is set before us...

Gal. 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

We are told to abandon those sins which drag us under... Sin places us back under its control once we have sinned and tries to dominate us. Sins domination is destructive... Do you want a life of *demolition*?

If you do not *guard yourself against...* and *stand apart* from those things (those sins which caused your fall before) *in your past...* now once being delivered into liberty... you may once again become *entangled* and *overtaken by the yoke of sin...* taking you away from serving Jesus Christ by yielding yourself to your lust for your wrong desires! FORSAKING JESUS? DEPARTURE FROM SERVING THE LORD? **Demas *lusted ... followed his desires*** and no Scriptures are found beyond this one... *he departed from the faith... he never came back to the Lord.* It is very possible for your sin... your lust... your desires... to overthrow your salvation in Jesus Christ!

2Tim. 4:10 For Demas (once a follower of Jesus) hath forsaken me, having loved (lusted after) this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica

Not one is exempt! If we were smart we would remember our former states and understand how tactically the enemy, the world, and the flesh are still at war with us in this life and acknowledge our dependency upon the Holy Spirit' power and His Holy Word to keep us.

Jn. 17:15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil (the evil one).

Jn. 17:17 Sanctify (cleanse them) them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

Jas. 1:27 ...undefiled before God and the Father is this, ...to keep himself unspotted from the world.

1Pet. 1:5 Who are kept by the power of God through (a fervent) faith (((unto salvation))) ready to be revealed in the last time.

Rev. 3:10 Because thou hast kept the word... I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation...

Jude 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy...

The Great Escape Unto Eternal Security In Your Salvation

Rom. 6:19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity (weakness) of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.

2Tim. 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

2Pet. 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

2Tim. 2:19 Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his (fully possessed of Him). And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.

We Are The Body Of Jesus Christ

1Corn. 6:15 Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid.

The revelation that as believers we are an actual member of the Body of Jesus Christ places us into a unique position... as such we can no longer see ourselves as doing those things that would be attached to the former life... because we have this new life in Christ.

Rom. 6:1-4 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Are We The Temple Of The Holy Spirit?

1Corin. 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

The body is the temple in which God's Spirit was designed to dwell. But in making our body His dwelling place He must possess us in our spirit man. That is where the crux is... whether we are totally given to Him in our hearts or are harboring places in which these lusts are stored... and held never allowing Jesus to take full possession of our being.

1Corin. 3:17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.

What does *defilement* mean but one who once was His temple and now faces the Lord's departure and their own destruction? *Defilement* according to the term "*Temple*" indicates a holy ground, a designated place for the Lord and His Spirit to dwell to which was always a place of holiness and purity on account of man's approach and need for connection and fellowship with God.

Ezek. 18:24 But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die.

The Unclean And Defiled

When the righteous thwart their own position for their own lust... they become defiled (unclean).

Rev. 3:4 Thou hast a few names(the faithful)... which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.

Rev. 16:15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

We are to keep our garments – given by the Lord, in purity... kept through our relationship in purity.

A Change Of Raiment

The verses before this one below Satan is contending due to the worn defiled garment. The following speaks of the cleansing and taking away of our sins by the Lord so that we might be without spot.

Zech. 3:3-5 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel. And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment. And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the LORD stood by.

Exod. 29:6 And thou shalt put the mitre upon his head, and put the holy crown upon the mitre.

Filthy garments here are cleansed through a change of raiment given us by the Lord. The Mitre is the crown wore by the priest before the Lord and upon this crown is inscribed “**Holiness Unto the Lord**” across its headband. This means *to live a life of consecration*. As the priesthood of believers we are to live our lives unto the Lord in pleasing Him allowing the Lord to live His life through us. This is a holy walk hand in hand with our Lord.

2Pet. 3:14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.

Be Diligent! He says in this...

“Being found... of Him”... (in this state of holy pleasing pursuit and reverence when Jesus returns) without spot and blameless... (engaged in this relationship with the Lord one can continually be washed and assured of God’s Spirit)

Hunger For Wholeness, Cleansing And Full Possession

1Thess. 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ps 119:9 Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.

Ps 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

Jn. 17:17 Sanctify (cleanse them) them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

1Jn. 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

Heb. 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Eph. 5:18 ...be filled (possessed and continually occupied) with the Spirit (the Holy Spirit)

Jude 1:20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost

2Tim. 2:19 Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his (His own – those fully possessed of Him). And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.

A Simple Prayer For Deliverance

Ps 71:2 Deliver me in thy righteousness, and cause me to escape: incline thine ear unto me, and save me.
