Revival Rains Pour Down Through Open Heavens - By The Cross

*What I believe we will be seeing in the coming days of revival... "Come Lord Jesus."
There is a river which is flowing from the Cross..and outpouring upon those who are
thirst after the Lord.*

***Gen. 28:17 And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is this place! this is none other
but the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven.***

Through the Cross the Gate of Heaven has been opened.

***Jn. 1:51 And he saith unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see
heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man.***

Jesus is speaking here on Himself and what the Cross would do. I believe angelic
activities will be increased in these last days' weeks of harvest.

***Mal 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine
house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the
windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough
to receive it.***

The Covenant of God which is only through the Cross has opened the windows of heaven
for us! The reference to *the tithe* is exemplified for us here...and is a reference to the
spreading of God's Kingdom (His rule and reign) on earth of which the revival will do!
To those who are faithful to the tithe they will see this revival because of their support of
the Gospel of God.

***Rev. 3:8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man
can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied
my name.***

Unto the faith to His Word and to His Name...the Lord shall give an open door...this
means the revival will start with the faithful. Though a small number...this people will
receive His outpouring revival and then spread it in the earth.

***Jerm. 3:3 Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter
rain; and thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed.***

Sin has closed God's the windows of heaven for those who do not know the Lord.

***Jerm. 5:24 Neither say they in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, that
giveth rain, both the former and the latter, in his season: he reserveth unto us the
appointed weeks of the harvest.***

The weeks of harvest spoken off here are is season of revival which is termed "*former
and latter rain.*"

***Prov. 16:15 In the light of the king's countenance is life; and his favour is as a cloud
of the latter rain.***

When the Lord draws near in the revival His countenance is as a cloud of the latter rain.

Joel 2:23 Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

The revival to come is both former and latter rain combined this means a double portion of the Book of Acts when the Lord touches and pours out His Spirit.

Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy

The Lord will pour out His Spirit in this last day revival!

Zec. 10:1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.

The bright clouds of His presents will be seen in this revival just like the glory which was with the ark of the Covenant in the Holy of Holies.

Hos. 6:3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

The revival is described as rain...and it shall be poured down upon us!

Am. 4:7 And also I have withholden the rain from you, when there were yet three months to the harvest; and I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city: one piece was rained upon, and the piece whereupon it rained not withered.

Not all cities in our country will receive the revival rains...some will not because they will not repent and yield to the Lord. The Lord will pour out His Spirit upon those who will hear and receive Him.

Prov. 1:23 Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.

The Lord will make Himself known to them who listen to the message of the Cross. He will open the windows of heaven for those who place their trust in His Cross. Those who repent from their wrong ways and turn to Him He shall receive, pour out upon and fill.

Jerm. 51:16 When he uttereth his voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens; and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth: he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures.

Both His judgments and revival will both be present at the coming of this revival. "He maketh lightnings with rain!"

Ezek. 1:28 As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness

of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

The brightness described here is the very Holy Spirit. People will be able to see the Lord's cloud and brightness present in these revival meetings... the very cloud and brightness of His Spirit will hover over these meetings!

Jas 5:7 Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

Again the Lord in the last days will do this thing...in the earth. It will be marvelous to be involved in these meetings and days of revival.

Jas 5:17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. 18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

Prayer and faith in the Cross has made the windows heaven open for us... the heavens will pour out this abundance of the Lord presence in this revival!

Rev. 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Just like these who had power to shut the Lord has given us the power to open...and will cause His rain to pour down upon us.

1Kgs. 18:41 And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for there is a sound of abundance of rain. 42 So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees

What this abundance of rain means to us is that the Lord's Spirit will come and touch men and cause them to be saved like no other time in history.

Ezek. 47:3,4,5 And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters; the waters were to the ankles. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters were to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters were to the loins. Afterward he measured a thousand; and it was a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

The waters of revival are poured out through the Cross...those living waters...which will become a river of revival in the earth. At the start the river of revival and this flood will rise as described in Ezekiel 47 until it is a river which is out of control. No man will be able to stop the tide of this last day revival though they may try. The force of God's Holy Spirit will be so powerful in these days.

2Chon. 5:13,14 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

The cloud of His Spirit and glory filled the whole house...overpowered them. The presence of the Lord's Spirit will be so strong it will lay people out in the Spirit when His presence is known.

Ac 2:1-4 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Here we see that the wind of the Spirit blew upon them...

the fire or brightness of the Lord's Spirit appeared to them... they were filled with His Spirit!

Gen. 5:24 And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

Enoch is a type of the church which in this revival will walk so closely into the Lord's presence that they will be taken as Enoch was. I believe that this revival will end up with the church being translated due to the Rapture occurring.
