Who Is The Messiah According To Scriptures

Yeshua (Jesus) The Messiah Is The Word

John 1:1-4 Hebrew rendering of the passage.

John 1:1,2,3,4 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God and the Word was the (ha) God (theos). He (Yeshua) was in the beginning with God. All things through him (Yeshua) came into being, and without him (Yeshua) came into being not even one thing which has come into being.

The Word was God. Hebrew (**Ha' Theos) the God.**

The Word – this Word is God; a God who does not speak, a wordless God is no God.

This is the God which speaks divine word.

Isa. 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

Cross ref.

Yeshua is called the Word of God

1John 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of **the Word of life** (Yeshua)

Rev. 19:13 And he (Yeshua) was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God.**

Yochannan (John) is speaking about two (the Word was with God) in the Hebraic rendering we learn that the Word was not a created being. Thus the messiah existed before all creation, in fact he was involved in creation (Col.1:15-17; Mark 1:2-3) Yochannan's theme is Yeshua the messiah the light of the world.

In him (Yeshua) life (Zoe – the very essence of God's life) was, and the life was the light of men. And the light in the darkness appears, and the darkness it apprehended not.

Yeshua is called G-d And Creator

1Cor. 8:6 But to us there is but one God (theos), the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord (kurios – ADONAI) Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.

Yeshua is The Son – The Very Essence - God

Hebrews 1:4-9

Heb 1:4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they. For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son? And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him. And of the angels he saith, Who maketh his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire. **But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever:** a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; **therefore God (calling Yeshua God), even thy God,** hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

David is speaking here of ADONAI

Ps 110:1 The LORD (YHWH) said unto my Lord (ADONAI), Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Mt 22:42,43,44,45 Saying, What think ye of Christ (Messiah)? whose son is he? They say unto him, The Son of David. He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord (ADONAI), saying, The LORD (YHWH) said unto my Lord (ADONAI), Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? If David then call him Lord (ADONAI), how is he his son?

Answer He is Messiah Yeshua

Yeshua Messiah is Called God

1Tim. 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God (Theos) was **manifest in the flesh** (sarx), justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached (gave divine truth) unto the Gentiles (ethos), believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Isa. 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name **Immanuel** (immanu EL).

Matt. 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name **Emmanuel** (immanu EL), which being interpreted is, **God**(theos) **with us**.

Theos with men /Theos manifest in the flesh (sarx)

The Son Of YHWH G-d

Mark 14:61-62 But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of "the Blessed" (**Yahweh G-d**)? And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Luke 22:70 Then said they all, Art thou then the Son of God? And he said unto them, **Ye say that I am** (according to the Scriptures which are being fulfilled in this very act - this proves that I am the messiah).
"You prove that I am He."
