THE DANGERS OF FALSE TEACHING

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BEWARE OF THE LEAVEN – Signs Of Man-Made Philosophies

Once the leaven enters it puffs up. Leaven represents that which spreads. Jesus used it in talking about false teaching and corruption. When someone opens themselves up to false teaching it is because they do not have a pure heart. Something inside – wrong motives begin to surface and take over once the person gives place to the leaven. Once the leaven enters in they are puffed up, and fall away by these new views. The enemy empowers false views and causes them to spread as described by Jesus. It doesn't take long for that leaven which was hidden to be known, because it has spread throughout, convincing the hearer to follow error and can also lead others to follow with them in it. False teaching is full of contradictions which are called "hypocrisies." Most people who have embraced the leaven (of error and corruption) do not see themselves in them being blind, but they are presently known to the discerning whose eyes are open and have their foundations in the truth. Hypocrisy always gives warning by its wrong motives of heart.

Mt 13:33 Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

Mt 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

Mt 16:11 How is it that ye do not understand that I spake it not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?

Mt 16:12 Then understood they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

Mr 8:15 And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and of the leaven of Herod.

Lu 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

Lu 13:21 It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.

1Co 5:6 Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?

1Co 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

1Co 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Ga 5:9 A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.

SUBVERSION

Subversion is the product of the leaven...it corrupts the whole. Leaven spreads throughout the whole. People can be subverted away from the true of God's word. This means their views can be corrupted, or they can be taken over by these philosophies. It is here that the quality of life can be altered and cause many misfortunes. The only way one can be set free from false teaching is to receive the truth. This means sitting under the anointed ministry of the Holy Spirit and the Lord's Holy Word being instructed by His appointed men. Those under false teachers need restoration and spiritual grounding in God's Word. Once the right foundation is in place their quality of life will be better because their belief system will be flowing in God's perfect will, being grounded by His Word.
